**DEATH, PERMANENT TOTAL DISABILITY, OR PERMANENT PARTIAL DISABILITY IF AMPUTATION OF A MEMBER OR ENUCLEATION OF AN EYE**

Recipients of death and PTD benefits may be entitled to cost-of-living adjustments through the Rate Adjustment Fund.  
Death benefits are paid for 25 years or \$500,000, whichever is greater.

New TTD minimums take effect with increases in the minimum wage each July 1, but appear in the July 15 rate. The statewide minimum wage increased to \$8.25 on July 1, 2010.

**PERMANENT PARTIAL DISABILITY IF NOT AMPUTATION OF A MEMBER OR ENUCLEATION OF AN EYE**

Effective 2/1/06, the maximum 8(d)1 (wage differential) award is equal to the SAWW, and the minimums are the same as the TTD minimums.

7/1/09 - 6/30/10: \$664.72\*

7/1/10 - 6/30/11: \$669.64

7/1/11 - 6/30/12: \$695.78

7/1/12 - 6/30/13: \$712.55

7/1/13 - 6/30/14: \$721.66

7/1/14 - 6/30/15: \$735.37

The PPD minimum rate is the same as the TTD minimum rate (see above).
